New Braunfels Utilities Announces Temporary Closure of IH-35 for Utility Work on Sunday, February 24, 2019

(New Braunfels, TX – February 22, 2019) – New Braunfels Utilities (NBU) has contracted with Greenstone Electrical Services to replace power lines and power poles along IH-35 near Camping World to between FM 306 and Conrads Lane on Sunday, February 24, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. The North and South bound lanes of traffic on IH-35 and the access roads that run parallel to the highway will be closed intermittently during this time.

Delays should be expected while work is being done. Advanced warning signs and traffic control devices will be in place. This temporary closure is necessary for the safety of the utility workers and travelers as high voltage lines are being replaced.

Work is expected to be completed in the timeframe noted, pending weather and other factors.
